

Re-purchase of Grave Rights - *after expiry of original Rights.*

The Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial is issued for a set period. From the 1940s this was for a period of 50 years. The Deed will state when the Rights were issued and for how long. Once the Rights have expired, the ownership reverts to the Burial Authority/Council.

To re-purchase the Rights to a grave, please fill in and return this form to the Cemetery Office, with the original Deed and appropriate fee. The Rights can be purchased for up to 100 years, and we will send you a new Deed showing how many years have been re-purchased. This can also be extended in the future.

Payment can be made by debit card, cheque (payable to L.B.R.U.T), in cash, or by credit card, which is subject to a handling fee.
