

LONDON LOCAL AUTHORITIES ACT 1996 PART III
STANDARD CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO OCCASIONAL SALES LICENCE

1. COMMENCEMENT

The sale shall not start before 8.00am.

2. DURATION

The sale shall cease at or before 6.00pm.

3. VEHICLE ACCOMODATION

(a) Vehicle access routes and parking areas shall be clearly separated from pedestrian and sales area.

(b) Adequate signs, notices and traffic stewards shall be provided to direct traffic entering and leaving the parking area

(c) Cars shall not be permitted to park on soft ground.

4. ROAD CONGESTION

Adequate signs, notice and traffic stewards shall be provided to conduct vehicles to and from the site with causing congestion or danger to other road users.

5. LITTER

(a) The site shall be provided with adequate waste containers around the site.

(b) After the close of the sale the licensee shall clear the site of all waste material and litter produced by the sale activities.

6. NOISE

No amplified announcements or music (including the playing of car radios) shall be permitted in the sale area.

7. DISPLAY OF NAMES AND ADDRESSES

Vendors

Each person selling articles at the sale shall prominently and publicly display their name and address.

Licensee

The full name and business address of the licensee shall be prominently and publicly displayed at the sale and on any notices, leaflets or posters given, distributed or exhibited in connection with the sale.

Complaints

The full name and address of the person appointed by the licensee to receive and answer complaints shall be prominently and publicly displayed at the sale and on any notices, leaflets or posters given, distributed or exhibited in connection with the sale.

8. ADMISSION OF OFFICERS

Authorised Council and Police Officers shall be admitted to the sale premised on request.
