


# Do you care about the community where you live?

**OWL (Online Watch Link)** is a new communications platform supported by Richmond Council, the Richmond Community Safety Partnership, the Met Police Safer Neighbourhood Teams and the Neighbourhood Watch Schemes. It brings together critical crime, public health and safety information into one place and shares real time updates with members.

Once signed up to the OWL neighbourhood watch, you will be added to a watch of the 50 or so homes closest to you and can expect to receive updates right away, such as:

- Policing updates
- Community Safety updates
- Scam alerts
- COVID-19 advice
- Crime prevention advice
- Domestic abuse information

OWL also allows members to report issues and crimes in their areas and respond to alerts with new intelligence.
